SAVE HAGGETTS POND TRAIL

Why attend the March 11th Andover Special Town Meeting?

The Town of Andover plans to excavate and pave an 8'+ wide multi-use trail along Haggetts Pond, our town's water supply. We support creating ADA trails in Andover, but ADA compliance does not require asphalt nor is it the preferred choice of those who fight to preserve natural spaces. The Town has not been responsive to residents' concerns on public safety or environmental impact. Hence, calling for a Special Town Meeting to vote on a zoning article to protect our town's drinking water is the only way to allow citizens to have any say in this project. Amendments to the zoning articles will be presented at the March 11th Special Town Meeting. The Finance Committee report mailed to residents does not include nor address the amendments to the articles.



Voting YES on the Amended Articles:

- Limits the use of asphalt in our Priority One* watershed and push for ALTERNATIVE SURFACES for ADA COMPLIANCE.
- Protects our GREEN SPACES, WILDLIFE and WATER SUPPLY.
- Advocates for FISCAL RESPONSIBILITY and INCLUSIVE GOVERNANCE in this \$1.75 million project, never approved by voters.
